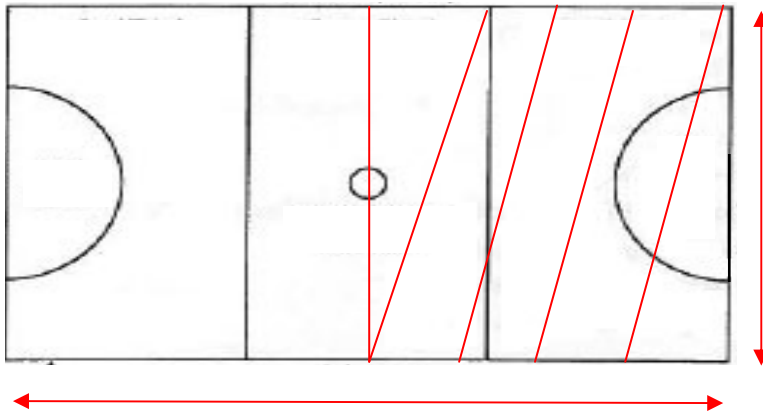

1	Do the rules state that extra time will be 5 minutes each way?	NO
2	From the team bench is Coaching permitted during a stoppage?	YES
3	Does the timekeeper have to notify the umpires when 30 seconds and 10 seconds remains prior to the start of each quarter?	YES
4	Can the Umpires change to control the other half of the Court at each interval?	NO
5	Is there a limit to the number of substitutions which can be made by a team?	NO
6	Is a team allowed three injury stoppages of up to two minutes in any one quarter?	NO
7	The W.A. without the ball, runs across the goal circle. Is she offside?	YES
8	Does the Umpire penalise a player who jumps from outside the Court, catches the ball and then lands within the Court?	YES
9	Is it the Umpire's responsibility to check the positions of the players before blowing the whistle for a Centre Pass?	NO
10	Two opposing players simultaneously enter the centre Court before the whistle for the Centre Pass. One then touches the ball. Should the Umpire take a Toss Up in the Centre Third?	YES
11	At a red Centre Pass, may a red player jump from wholly within the Centre Third and land with her first foot in the Goal Third and her second foot in the Centre Third?	NO
12	May a player bounce the ball to another player?	YES

22. What three things about the positioning and posture of the two players must the umpire check before releasing the ball at a Toss-Up?

(3 marks)

A: The two players shall stand facing each other and their own goal ends with arms straight and hands to sides, but feet in any position. There shall be a distance of 0.9 m (3 feet) between the nearer foot of each player concerned. They shall not move from that position until the whistle is blown.

23. The Captain winning the toss before the start of the game can choose one of two options. Give the two options.

(2 marks)

A: Choice of goal end or first Centre Pass.

24. What do these hand signals mean?

(2 marks)



A: Toss Up

B: Obstruction

25. A Penalty Pass is awarded for Obstruction; where must the penalised player stand whilst the penalty is taken?

(1 mark)

A : The **penalised** player must stand beside and away from the player taking the penalty so as not to impede this player in any way.
